Don't Give Out Personal Information

Keep your personal information private. Don't give out your phone number, address or email to anyone you don't know



Be careful of requests

Only accept 'friend' requests from people you know in real life. This reduces the chance of getting into an unsafe situation.

Block anyone you've had contact with that was negative or unsafe.



Keep your online friends online

Never agree to meet someone you've only known online on your own. Take one of your parents with you and meet in a public place.

If they are who they say they are, they'll be happy to do this.

Be mindful

Taking, sending or receiving a sexy image of a person under 18 can be illegal in some States – even if it's of yourself! Anything posted on line can stay on line for a long time



Be Cautious with Public Wifi

Be careful when you use public wifi. When accessing public networks, anyone can get access to your information or harm your device.

Be Alert

There are people who try to meet children on line for bad reasons, sometimes of a sexual nature. This is against the law.
